	<p>Third Sunday of Easter</p> <p>Have you ever had an "aha" moment? They can be quite rare, but when we get one, we know it. It comes as an instant recognition, a realization, a light dawning—we suddenly 'get it,' sometimes after a long period of seeming quite dense. And that can feel awfully good. Psychology is looking increasingly at what happens when our brain and body make a 'mindful' connection. Athletes call this 'being in the zone'-- that perfect moment when you can do no wrong. Mystics understand that this connection takes place in the soul. This is the sort of epiphany the disciples experienced while walking on the road to Emmaus with Jesus. There are two key elements of the miracle that occurred on that first Easter, and they remain with us to this day in the gift of Mass—sharing the Word and sharing the Eucharist. After Jesus shared the scriptures with the disciples, "When he was at the table with them, he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. Then their eyes were opened, and they recognized him; and he vanished from their sight." Think about it! If we open ourselves up to the miracle of Christ in the Word and in the Eucharist, here and now, he is here with us again. And that is a miracle.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Patrick M.
