**Diocese of Valleyfield: Obituary Announcement:**  
**BISHOP ROBERT LABEL**

On May 25, 2015, at the Dr-Aimé-Leduc Center, Bishop Robert Label (born Nov 8, 1924), Emeritus Bishop of the Diocese of Valleyfield, entered the house of God at the age of 90 years.

Ordained a priest on June 18, 1950 at Notre-Dame-des-Neiges in Trois-Pistoles, Quebec, by Bishop Georges Courchesne, Archbishop of Rimouski, Bishop Label was On March 12, 1974, appointed Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Saint-Jean- Longueuil and ordained bishop on May 12, 1974. On March 31, 1976, at the age of 51, he was named the sixth bishop of Valleyfield. He shepherded the diocese of Valleyfield until June 29, 2000 when he became Emeritus.

Along with Bishop Noël Simard, Bishop Robert Label is survived by his diocesan families of Rimouski, Saint-Jean-Longueuil and Valleyfield, his sisters, Mrs. Cécile Label-Rioux, Mrs. Lucienne Label-Lagacé, Sister Annette Label, SRC, Mrs. Denise Label-Morency, his brother Dr. Marcel Label, his nephews, nieces, and members of the families of Label, Bélanger, Lagacé and Pettigrew.

The remains of Bishop Label will be exposed at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Cecilia in Salaberry-de-Valleyfield, on Tuesday, June 2, 2015, from 2:00 pm to 9:00 pm, and on Wednesday, June 3 from 10:30 am onwards. The Funeral Mass, presided by Bishop Noël Simard, will take place at 2:00 pm at the same location. The Burial will follow in the Valleyfield cemetery where he will rest in the grounds reserved for bishops. A celebration of the Word will be held on Tuesday, June 2 at 7:30 pm, hosted by St. Clement Parish of Beauharnois.

**TRINITY SUNDAY**

**GOD CALLED AND** chose a people. As Moses says God took "a nation for himself." This call was not about following rules but about relationship. God offers a covenant, not a contract. We are given rules, but they are to help us to live out that intimate relationship. Jesus sent his disciples out to make more disciples. They were not simply finding people who would "obey everything that I have commanded you," but people who would share in the relationship the disciples had with Christ, with the Father and with the Spirit. Paul tells us that the Holy Spirit is the key to our relationship with the Trinity. The Spirit, the bond between the Father and the Son, is alive in our midst, uniting us to the Trinity of love and to one another. The rules follow from and feed the relationship. God, mysteriously, lives in relationship: the Trinity, though one God, is a loving, life-giving relationship of three Divine Persons, and we are invited to share in that unity. Through the power of the Holy Spirit we can cry "Abba! Father," because we are co-heirs with Jesus our brother and children of his Father. We are people of great dignity and of great responsibility. We are the people the Lord has chosen as his heritage.
