THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

ALL OF YOU ARE ONE IN CHRIST JESUS. When our bishop, Paul Marchand, SMM, died suddenly a couple of years ago, he left behind notes showing what the diocesan priority would be for the new year: "Jesus is ...for me." Today's readings lead us to reflect on this very statement and contemplate anew who Jesus is in our lives. Jesus' question to Peter – "Who do you say that I am?" – asks more than "What is my name?" Jesus beckons Peter to reflect on who he is to Peter. This calls for reflection on Peter's part and goes beyond pondering Jesus' reputation. The scriptures assign Jesus many titles and each one evokes a different facet of the Son of God. At times in our lives we may call upon Jesus as Shepherd, Healer, Brother or Counsellor to guide and sustain us. In the second reading, Paul reinforces the grace of our baptism, affirming that through our baptism we have put on Christ whom we 'wear' identifies us – and who will people say that we are? Our new identity in baptism calls us to follow Christ with hearts open to the needs of others and to the many opportunities in our days to live in the salvation of God. As we journey through our week, let us pause and reflect on bishop Marchand's statement, "Jesus is ...for me" and on Jesus' question, "Who do you say that I am?" *Susan Berlinger, Kirkland Lake, ON*
