You are invited to St. Mary's Cathedral, Ogdensburg, NY at 3:00 P.M., Sunday, June 28, 2015, for the SOLEMN VESPER Service at which Most Reverend Terry R. LaValley, Bishop of Ogdensburg, will preside at the Commissioning of 76 Candidates for Lay Ministry in the Diocese. St. Regis Parish can rejoice that 10 of these Candidates are members of our parish: Dawna Arbour, Rosemary Bonaparte, Shari Francis, Valerie Garrow, Bernice Lazore, Laura Morris, Carole Ross, Jamie Ross, Connie Thompson, and Sharon Thompson.

What are Lay Ministers? Since Vatican II, Lay Ministers have become a vital part of parish pastoral teams, especially in the ministry of outreach to the poor, catechetical instruction of children and adults, and youth ministry. Lay Ministers must complete two years of the Diocesan Formation For Ministry Program which includes courses in the following areas: Church, Scripture, Christology, Spirituality, Communications, Sacraments, Moral Theology, and Social Justice. Over the two-year program, candidates also participate in seven workshops and two retreats to intensify their own spiritual growth. They receive training in liturgical and worship ministry so that they can assist their pastor in the work of the parish.


Prayerful Congratulations to these ten parishioners who have generously sacrificed time and talent to receive training in Lay Ministry! Thanks to their families who have supported their efforts!

We are grateful to Deacon Patrick Donahue and many priests and nuns of the Diocese of Ogdensburg who have educated the candidates over the past two years. Special thanks are due to Father Jerome Pastores, former St. Regis Parish Administrator who initiated this program for our parish in 2013 and to the present Administrator, Father Anthony Osuji who has continued to encourage these parishioners.

At this time, we extend our gratitude also to the Society of the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Diocese of Ogdensburg, who have donated Ministry Grants. totaling \$9,400 to St. Regis Church to help the parish to pay costs for Tuition, Workshops, and Retreats for our Lay Ministry Program.


Above all, we praise and thank God for calling us to His service and for sustaining us by the Gifts of His Holy Spirit as we seek to bring the love, the mercy, the message of Jesus Christ, our Savior to our neighbors.
