16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

JEREMIAH AND JESUS were both fully aware of the chaos and stress inherent in gathering sheep! In our readings today, Jeremiah underlines how a good shepherd brings his flock together in their fold and attends to their needs, not only for safety, but so that they might be fruitful and multiply. Jesus, on the other hand, compares the crowds following him to sheep looking for a shepherd. Turning away from a retreat with his disciples, he reaches out with compassion to these people who incessantly look to him for attention. How truly our Lord Jesus Christ fulfills the role of Good Shepherd for us as Church. Other ‘shepherds’ have little power to truly care for us and bring us together into the peace of our fold, the embrace of God. It is Christ Jesus, Saint Paul says in his letter to the Ephesians, who is our peace, who put hostility to death through the cross, both as sacrificial lamb and as shepherd, to reconcile us as one body to God. As we approach Mass today, are we presently milling around like shepherd-less sheep – as Church, as community, as family or as individuals? Let us each be enfolded by the compassion of the Good Shepherd, as he calls us to his table to partake of the unity, reconciliation and fruitfulness of his holy Eucharist.
