**Meditation**

**16<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
 I REMEMBER MY favorite high school teacher saying: "We all have a disability – no one is perfect." This hit home with me, as all through school I often felt I wasn't strong enough or good enough to succeed or make a difference. Today's readings show us that God's strength is all that we need. In the First Reading from Wisdom, we are reminded that although we all have weaknesses, God is always there to help-even if we don't pray for guidance as often as we should. God holds firm when we doubt and shows mildness when we turn away. The Psalmist reminds us that, in spite of our weaknesses, God is ever "good and forgiving." The Psalmist's simple prayer could be our own: "Give your strength to your servant." Like the teacher whose simple statement gave me courage and comfort, Jesus speaks in ways we can understand by using parables to demonstrate truths about the kingdom of God. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus uses different parables to teach us life lessons. The Weeds among the Wheat, The Mustard Seed and The Yeast are three examples of seeming weakness or insignificance that, given time, result in fruitfulness and new life. Let us take to heart these homely, earthy images and the lessons they bring- and let us go into the world to apply these lessons in our daily lives.
