THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

MARY HAS CHOSEN THE BETTER PART. For anyone of us gifted with the resources to be hospitable, entertaining is a gratifying activity, especially when welcoming famous or beloved guests. In the readings today, Abraham and Martha both exercise their gifts of hospitality. Abraham hurries to entertain his mysterious visitors. After they accept "a little bread," he calls for Sarah to make up a batch of fresh cakes, and for his servants to prepare a fatted calf with fresh curds and milk. What a spread! Martha is no less busy preparing her finest fare for Jesus. In the end, the one fetes angels unawares and the other the Son of God. What memorable events! It is the Lord himself, though, who points out the better way of welcome. When Martha bursts out in frustration that her sister Mary is doing nothing to help, he gently rebuffs her busyness with many things and points out the better part: simply *being* with him, listening to his every word. In his letter to the Colossians, Paul nails down what it is to entertain the Holy Spirit: "the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory." Let us with Mary of Bethany be human beings rather than human doings, and give time to simply *being* with the Lord. *Beverly Illauga, Kemptville, ON.*
