Sunday Meditation

In today's Gospel, a Canaanite woman-foreigner-takes the risk of pleading with Jesus to cure her ill daughter. Undeterred when Jesus initially states that his mission is to the "lost sheep of the house of Israel," this courageous mother humbly renews her plea: "Lord help me." A dialogue ensues about dogs (puppies) eating crumbs from their master's table, and Jesus, deeply moved **by her great faith, grants her request. What a great lesson this Canaanite mother teaches us about persevering in prayer and experiencing the inclusive, loving heart of God. How important it is to be humbly forthright and confident when asking God for what we really need. Indeed, it is a call to trust that God answers sincere prayer from every human heart. A friend who is a priest put it nicely while on a visit to Japan, where he had been a missionary for many years. He remarked that, as a Church, we need to walk a very humble path, rejoicing and proclaiming how God has showered his gifts on everyone--not just on us! Today, St. Paul offers a revealing truth: God never takes back his gifts or calling. Both Jew and Gentile are promised membership in the kingdom of God through God's mercy, generously offered to all who sincerely seek it. May we truly live with humble hearts.**
