**Day of Prayer**  
**Sunday, 28<sup>th</sup> September is a Day of Prayer for the III Extraordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops**, scheduled to take place from 5<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> of October to treat the topic: The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization. Particular churches, parish communities, institutes of consecrated life, associations, families and individuals are invited to pray for this intention during Mass and at other liturgical celebrations, in the days leading to the synod and during the synod itself. The suggested prayers include the Prayer to the Holy Family for the Synod, composed by Pope Francis. The recitation of the Holy Rosary is also recommended for the duration of the Synodal assembly.

**Sunday Meditation:** Politicians are sometimes accused of flip-flopping, of holding a firm position on an issue only until it becomes clear that public opinion is going in another direction. The accusation may be valid in some cases, but may also be unfair. When a leader has the integrity and courage to share the reasoning behind his developing positions, his credibility is not diminished but enhanced. Jesus begins a discussion with some political and religious leaders of his own day by telling a parable about two sons. One says yes and the other says no to their father's command, but both change their minds. As the discussion moves forward, Jesus' emphasis is not on the values of consistency or of sticking with commitments. Instead he illustrates challenges and possibilities of growth and change that are deeply rooted in human intelligence and freedom. Sometimes dramatic conversions take place in people's lives, but for most of us our moral and spiritual evolution is gradual. Our responsibility is to monitor both our core values and the decisions that flow from them, to take conscious charge of the ways in which we are saying yes and no as we pursue the values of the gospel.

**Feast of the Archangels, Michael, Gabriel, Raphael - September 29**

The Archangels **Michael, Gabriel and Raphael** have important roles in the history of salvation.

**Saint Michael** is the "Prince of the Heavenly Host." His name is Hebrew for "Who is like God?" His forces cast Lucifer and the evil spirits into Hell when they rebelled against God. Michael is mentioned four times in the Bible, in Daniel 10 and 12, in the letter of Jude, and in Revelation. . Pope Leo XIII, in 1899, having had a prophetic vision of the evil that would be inflicted upon the Church and the world in the 20th century, instituted a prayer asking for Saint Michael's protection to be said at the end of every Mass.

**Saint Gabriel**, whose name means "God's strength," is mentioned four times in the Bible."I am Gabriel, who stand before God." (Luke 1,19). Gabriel announced to Zacharias, the birth of John the Baptist and to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Incarnation of the Word in her womb.

**Saint Raphael** 's name means "God has healed." He is the "Medicine of God", known for acts of healing and of mercy. He healed Tobias' blindness in the Book of Tobit. "I am the angel Raphael, one of the seven, who stand before the Lord" (Tob 12:15)
