## THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

**AT HIS GATE LAY A POOR MAN NAMED LAZARUS.** As one catchy country song goes, "Sometimes you're the windshield, sometimes you're the bug," It's true. Today's Gospel shows us both sides of the story. The rich man has it all – clothes, food, shelter, money, status and power. Lazarus has nothing. I have always taken Lazarus's side, and am pleased that he is rewarded in the end. After all, who wants to see themselves in that selfish rich man? Then I look around. I do not think of myself as rich, but I do have clothes, food, shelter, money, status and a certain amount of power. There are people like Lazarus at my gate. I pause, then read the rest of the story, Like the words from Amos in the First Reading, and like the Psalm, it's about justice. Not limited, near-sighted earthly justice. No. God's justice, where those who suffer are chosen first and lifted up to be with the angels. Meanwhile, the ones who have it easy on earth must look their hard-heartedness right in the eye. The rich man ran out of time before he could change his ways. But it's not too late for me to "pursue righteousness" and "take hold of the eternal life," as Paul urges Timothy to do.
