THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

THE LORD IS NEAR TO THE BROKEN-HEARTED. One of the most frequent objections I heard to the new translation of the Roman Missal concerned the re-insertion into the Penitential Act of the phrase, "through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault." "Who do they think we are?" the objectors grumbled. The short answer is "sinners". "I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and what I have failed to do." Look around the world: there's lots of evidence of human sinfulness. Each of us knows that sometimes it's my fault; sometimes it's not our fault, but we are in this together. We all bear the consequences of each other's sins, whether the "other" is perpetrating ethnic cleansing on the other side of the world, or abusing a child or spouse in the apartment down the hall, or tweeting the latest gossip, or looking the other way when we recognize the face of Christ in one of the least. "GOD, I thank you that I am not like other people." The problem with this stance is that I am like other people. I might wish I weren't, but the truth is we're all sinners. We tell the truth at the beginning of our celebration and we tell another, bigger truth: God in Christ has offered mercy to all of us. In whatever words, that's worth celebrating.
